I have made a php mysql select and echo thing to show a user the different questions and their answers. Now i want to update it, so i have a form where they can search for a question or answer. I know how to select the questions and answers from the database, that is easy. Now i want to display the questions and answers in a different order based on what they searched for in the form and how many times. So if they searched for "babysitter" i want to show just the babysitter questions and answers. So my question is if anyone has any suggestions for a good way of doing this in php or some pointers? A: If you have a predefined table structure, the most common way to do it is to use an array to generate the rows and columns of each question and an array to generate the answers. Your array could look something like this: \$rowCounts = array( 0 => "question1", 1 => "question2", 2 => "question3", 3 => "question4", 4 => "question5", 5 => "question6" ); \$rowKeys = array( 0 => "question1", 1 => "question2", 2 => "question3", 3 => "question4", 4 => "question5", 5 => "question6" ); \$answers = array( 0 => "answer1", 1 => "answer2", 2 => "answer3", 3 => "answer4",
